Trinity Theatre Proposal - Phase #1 details

Phase #1 could be completed by church personnel.

Prefabricating extension sections off site so disruption to the Sanctuary would be a matter of a few days.

- 1. extension of chancel 6 ft;
- 2. mobilization of the pulpit, lectern, communion table;
- 3. removal of choir pews and permanent risers in the choir loft (possibly replaced with our portable risers and chairs);
- 4. removal of one front pew only both sides of the main floor Sanctuary would then be the same, replaced with stacking chairs as/if needed;
- 5. organ stays of course;
- 6. the design allows for conversion from theater mode to church service mode in a matter minutes.
