Call to Worship and Prayer of Approach

All: **Prepare our hearts to receive this light. Let us become light bearers who bring the light of God's love to others. Amen.**

Prayer of Confession and Letting Go

One: We made it! We made it to 2026! Thanks be to God for the gift of a new beginning. In order to truly make it a new beginning we need to see if we are dragging along any "burdens" from last year. Is there anything we need to throw out with our Christmas wrapping? Let us pray:

Holy One, as we yearn to start this year afresh and renewed by your love, we dare to look deep into our own

hearts to see if there is anything we need to let go of in order to follow you. We confess any words or deeds done that escalated conflict instead of facilitating peace and harmony... (silence.) Let it go!

All: In the spirit of healing, we let it go.

One: We confess that there were people we meant to connect with, support, encourage and strengthen this past year. We didn't get to them all.... (silence.) Let it go!

All: In the Spirit of healing, we let it go.

One: We confess to those grudges and offences that we still cling to so tightly... (silence.) Let it go!

All: In the Spirit of healing, we let it go.

One: We confess to any personal goals around health and wholeness that we didn't get around to last year... (silence.) Let it go!

All: In the Spirit of healing, we let it go.

One: We offer up anything else that comes to mind that we need to let go of in order to be present to here and now, a new day, a new beginning, a fresh start... (silence.) Let it go!

All: God, take our burdens away. They do not serve any meaningful purpose. They do not give us the abundant life you promised us. Free us to be your gentle, joyful people. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
