

Mission & Service (M&S) 2025 Financial Report for Trinity by Shirley Boon, M&S Treasurer

WE DID IT! Our Trinity Family donated just over \$20,000 to Mission and Service in 2025! We met our budget commitment and added to it by individual donations through the church office and those sent directly to the National M&S office. Also included in this amount is the \$2,000 contribution by the United Church Women (UCW).

The 2025 receipt to Trinity states:
